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MOUNTIES CURRENT MATTERS

1. Complaints Management Follow Up

- Neighbours were informed that minimal complaints were received in the past year.
- With only a few complaints regarding noisy patrons and construction concerns, the club acted quickly to prevent repeat complaints. An overall great year.

No complaints or feedback received

2. Patron Behaviour

- Neighbours were advised that anti-social behaviour is on the decline due to the hard work of the board, management staff, bar staff and security.

No complaints or feedback received

3. Security

- An additional 500 cameras have been implemented and are now operational 24 hours a day.
- Introduction of new security manager David Borg, as well as security staff to monitor the premises each evening.
- Neighbour Complaint by Julie Bryce: Kewin Ave Side gate is not consistent with hours of operation and sometimes she endures a significant wait for and security operatives to respond.

DM to provide a solution after further discussions will held between management and security.

4. Traffic

- Neighbours have been advised that construction trucks will be entering the premises via Meadows road during DA approved hours, 8am to 5pm daily.
- Neighbour Complaint by Howard Grimshaw: concrete trucks have been reported to be driving down Rose Avenue at a fast pace.

DM has advised feedback will be passed on to Project Managers.

5. Noise Management

- Mounties have received great results from changing the music type in the Terrace Bar on a Friday and Saturday night to minimise the levels of anti-social behaviour.

6. General Business

Why we are in need of Facility Upgrade - Marketing and Demographic Stats presented clearly showing the local growth in population.

- Mounties sits in the middle of two LGA areas Population 378,000 residents – recognised as the Hub of the community.
- Members of Mounties site stands at 80,500
- Currently over 21,000 people on social media
- Over 30,000 receive Mounties What's On Guide via mail as well as regular advertisements in local newspapers
- Neighbour Request by Steve Emerson: discussed concern regarding the club approaching neighbours for acquisition, Mr Emerson has advised that they would like advanced warning when the club is looking to acquire properties and if it could be addressed at this forum.

7. Future Developments

DM informed neighbours the rear foyer renovations are currently underway with Stage 1 due to finish by December 9, 2015. Stage 2 will commence from December and will involve making good of the temp entry. Stage 3 will be the new membership area to open February.

DM provided a slide presentation outlining an overview of the New Development inclusive of the F&B project.

Upon reminding all guests of the Christmas Dinner in November, Darren Marino declared the meeting closed at 7.03pm and invited all present to enjoy light refreshments.
